As an accredited installer under the UK Microgeneration Certification Scheme (UK MCS), SolarTech Ltd can access funding through the Governments Low Carbon Buildings Programme (LCBP) Phase 2E scheme, meaning that SolarTech's Solar Hot Water, Photovoltaic and Heat Pump systems are subject to grants of up to 50% of the total purchase and installation cost.

LCBP Phase 2E Grant Eligibility

The LCBP Phase 2E scheme provides grant funding for the installation of various microgeneration technologies including Solar Hot Water, Photovoltaic and Heat Pump systems by organisations in the UK public and not-for-profit sectors, including;

- Local Authorities
- Housing Associations
- Schools, Colleges, Universities
- Hospitals
- Public Service Organisations
- Registered Charities

Under the rules of the programme, the supply and installation of these technologies can only be carried out by UK MCS accredited organisations such as SolarTech.
