New-Build: From 2008 onwards, all new-build social housing is required to meet Level 3 of the **Code for Sustainable Homes**.

Where higher code levels are set, PV and Heat Pump technologies can be integrated in to the design to help achieve the required reduction in CO₂ emissions.

Causing minimal disruption to the existing infrastructure, systems can be installed either as part of a wider refurbishment programme, or even when properties are under occupancy.
